



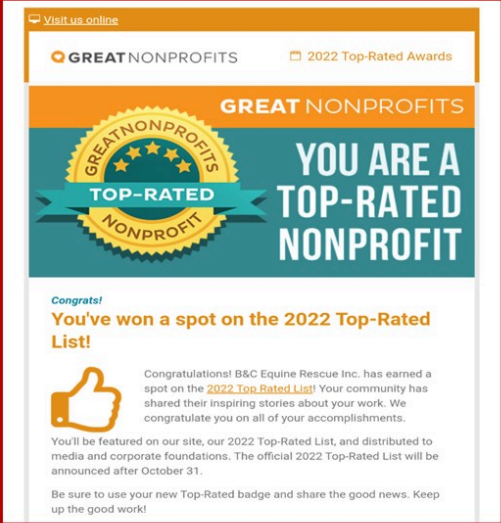

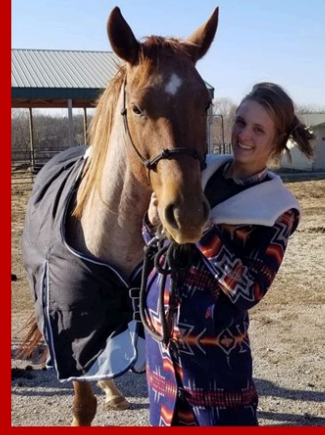
I know how important the Rescue work is. We are ALL THANKFUL for Brenda and Cecil and the Great work they do every single day!
